We expand quality care to enable mothers and children everywhere access to the same opportunities for a healthy future. An estimated 5.9 MILLION children under the age of 5 die each year because of malnutrition, inadequate healthcare and poor sanitation - all of which can be prevented.

How Rotary makes it happen? Rotary provides education, immunizations, birth kits and mobile health clinics. Women are taught how to prevent mother-to-infant HIV transmission, and other necessary tools to help them and their children to a more healthy life. Afghanistan:

- **No wild poliovirus type 1 (WPV1) cases were reported in the past week.** There are two WPV1 cases reported in 2019. The total number of WPV1 cases for 2018 remains 21.

Pakistan:

- **No cases of wild poliovirus type 1 (WPV1) were reported this week.** There are four WPV1 cases reported in 2019. The total number of WPV1 cases in 2018 remains 12.
