"Guten Tag" from the Missouri Rotary Youth Leadership Award (MO RYLA) Academy!

A Rotary International youth program found throughout the world, RYLA has over a 25-year history in Missouri. The Missouri RYLA Academy brings in high school students from Districts 6040, 6060, and 6080 each summer to spend four days on the William Woods University campus in Fulton, Missouri. Because of the program's outstanding curriculum and achievement, the academy now offers two sessions each summer, capable of hosting 100 students per session. To date, over 2,000 Missouri high school students can proudly call themselves "RYLArians."

Unique in so many ways, the MO RYLA Academy continues to thrive with innovative concepts. With 30 combined years of program leadership, Curriculum Director Rich Linden, a Kansas City Plaza Rotarian and Administrative Director Valerie Anderson from the North Kansas City Club, recognize the powerful impact that MO RYLA program can have on the rest of the Rotary world. With combined skills and passion, Rich and Valerie have accepted a formal invitation to present the RYLA breakout session in Hamburg, Germany at the Rotary International 2019 Convention in June!

Considered the Rotary International model service leadership development curriculum for high school aged participants, students dive deep into learning about Rotary and the power of service above self. Academy participants are immersed in service project development, learning valuable skills of how to put great service ideas into action. Missouri RYLAians return home to their communities on fire, invigorated and ready to serve their fellow men.

The Missouri RYLA Academy is one of the most successful and impactful programs that our district supports. It is a 4-day, 3-night training program for high school sophomores and juniors who exhibit a desire for community service. Developed by some of Missouri's top professional educators, the curriculum is designed to identify and enhance the qualities of Servant Leadership for each participant, train them on how to successfully implement a service project, and inspire them to live a lifetime of "Service Above Self." In addition, participants are exposed to all the programs and values Rotary has to offer. Established in 1992 with the support of Rotary districts 6060, 6040, and 6080, Missouri RYLA Academy has trained and inspired more than 2000 students state wide. It is has been identified as a model for RYLA Academies worldwide. In fact, Curriculum Director Rich Linden and Administrative Director Valarie Anderson have been accepted an invitation to present at the RI Convention this summer.

Luckily, you won't have to fly to Germany to hear more about RYLA. As part of their "World Domination Tour," Rich and Valarie will be the keynote speakers at the St. Louis Intercity Fellowship meeting hosted by the Rotary Club of Webster Groves on March 1.
