Council on Legislation Highlights

Highlights of the 2019 Rotary International Council on Legislation: The 4 day assembly involved 530 voting District Representatives and over 200 non-voting observers. Spirited debate and respectful disagreements punctuated the deliberations of 117 items proposed for consideration. Out of the 117 proposals, 47 were enacted, 14 withdrawn, 6 were reconsidered and 56 failed to pass. Some of the Highlights that passed:

- Extend a Club Presidents term by one year when a successor has not been elected.
- Club attendance make-ups are good for the entire year not just 14 days before or after a meeting.
- Rotary Classifications are no longer limited to a certain percentage of members.
- The RI Board may change the name of the Rotarian Magazine
- Upon the request of the District Governor, the Board may terminate a Club if its membership fall below 6 members
- RI Dues have been increase by \$1 a year through 2022-23
- RI is to take the appropriate action to change its tax status to 501(c) 3
- Rotaract Clubs are now RI Clubs, but Rotaractors are not Rotarians. Dues of Rotaractors to be determined by the RI Board

close. Let's finish the year strong for the Foundation!

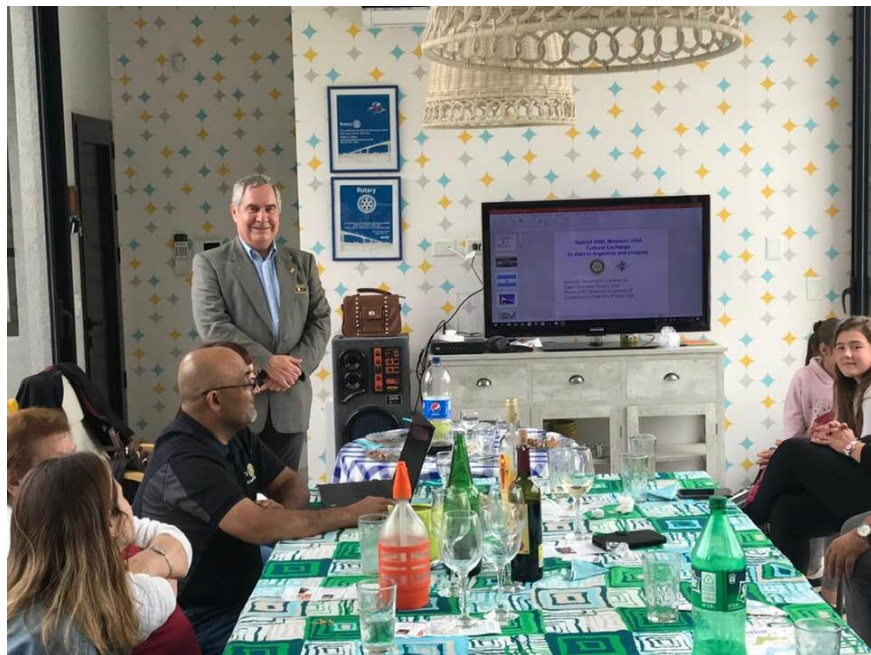
Significant Service Award
