## Resolution at Business Meeting during the District Conference

The following will be voted on at the District Conference on Saturday November 3 during the business meeting from 10am - 11:15am

Resolution

Whereas, the District Leadership Plan states in Article I, page 6 that the District Governor Elect serves as a member of the Finance Committee; and

Whereas, the District Leadership Plan states in Article II, page 13 that the Finance Committee omits the District Governor Elect as a named member; and

Whereas, Article VII of the District Leadership Plan provides for amendments to policies and procedures to be submitted for ratification at the next District Assembly; and

Whereas, the District Governor has requested an amendment to the District Leadership Plan Article II, page 13 that the District Governor Elect will be named as a member of the Finance Committee;

Now Therefore, be it resolved that at the District Assembly the Clubs will vote on amending the District Leadership Plan, Article II, page 13 that the Finance Committee shall consist of the District Governor as Chair, the two most recent Past District Governors willing to serve, and the District Governor Elect.
